Some of the improvements will include

- **Medications Asthma** has been separated into groups
 - Relievers
 - Symptom Contollers
 - Preventers
 - Combination
 - Oral Steroids
- **Medications Respiratory** - Respiratory medications have been moved to their own 'sub-tab'
- **Medications - Mental Health** - that are in the medications graph and MH Summary Report Card have been added to the Medications filter under the "Medications - Other" sub-tab
- **Conditions - Mental Health** - conditions are grouped into high prevalence, low prevalence, degenerative and developmental
